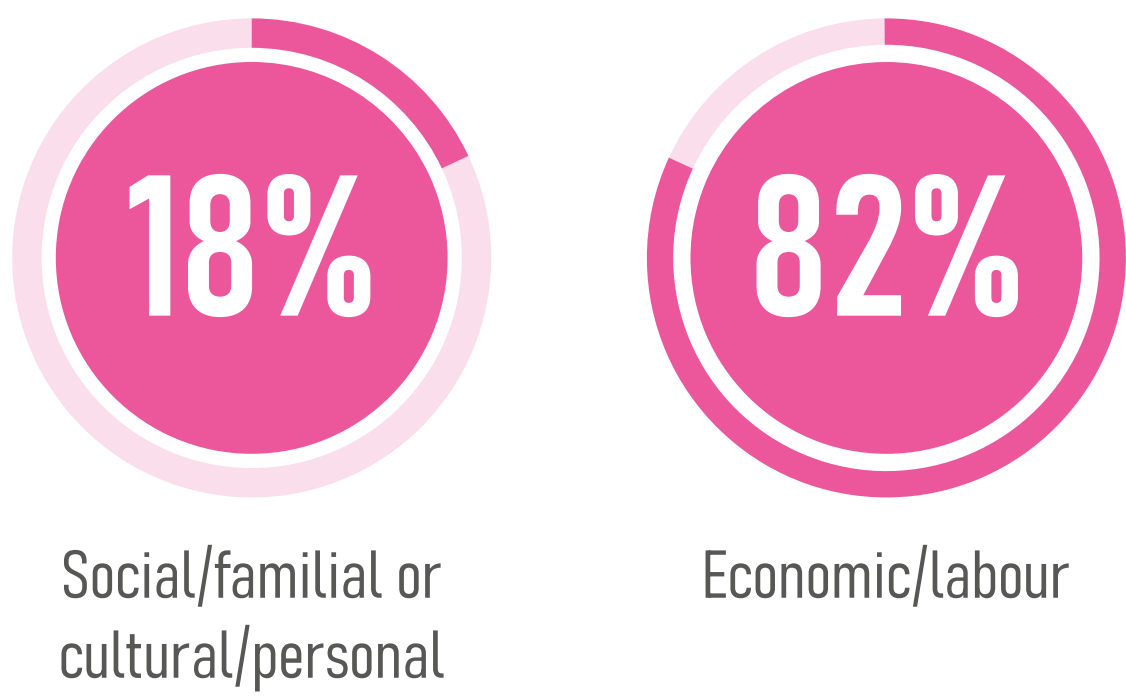


MIGRANT WOMEN IN LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN

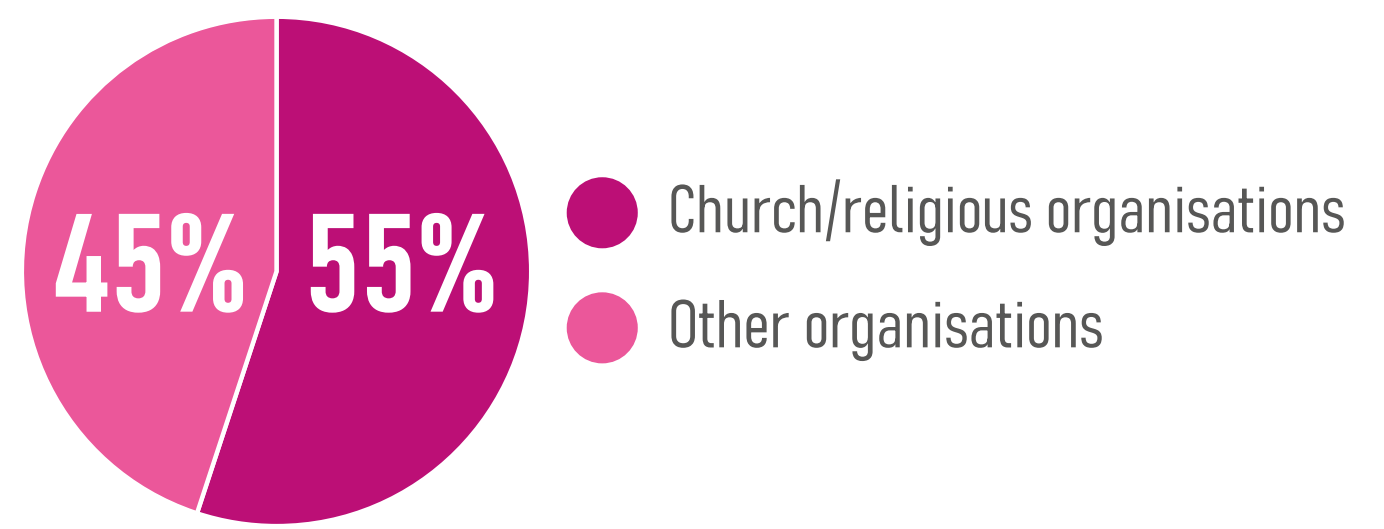

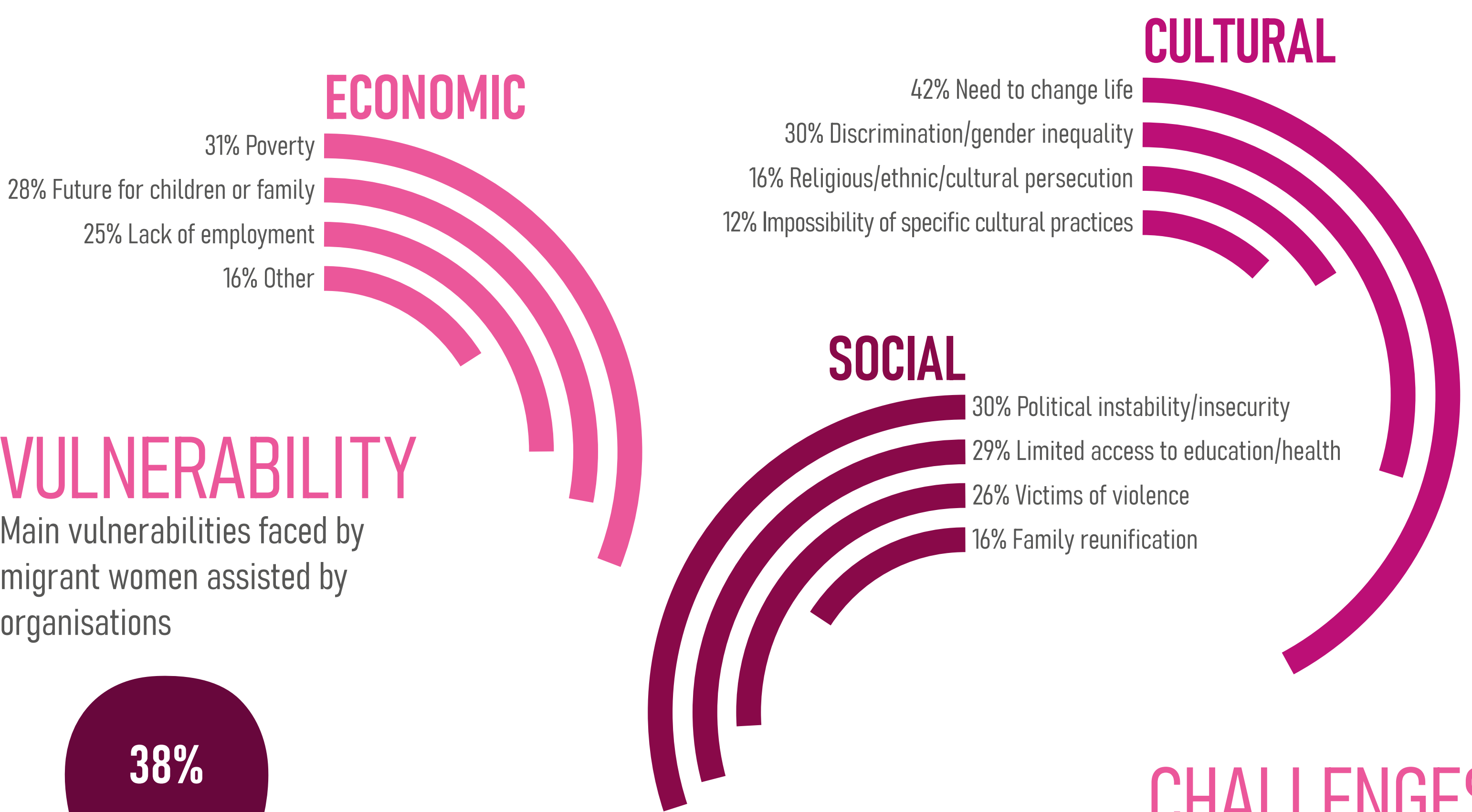

Type of organisations participating in the study and assisting migrant women

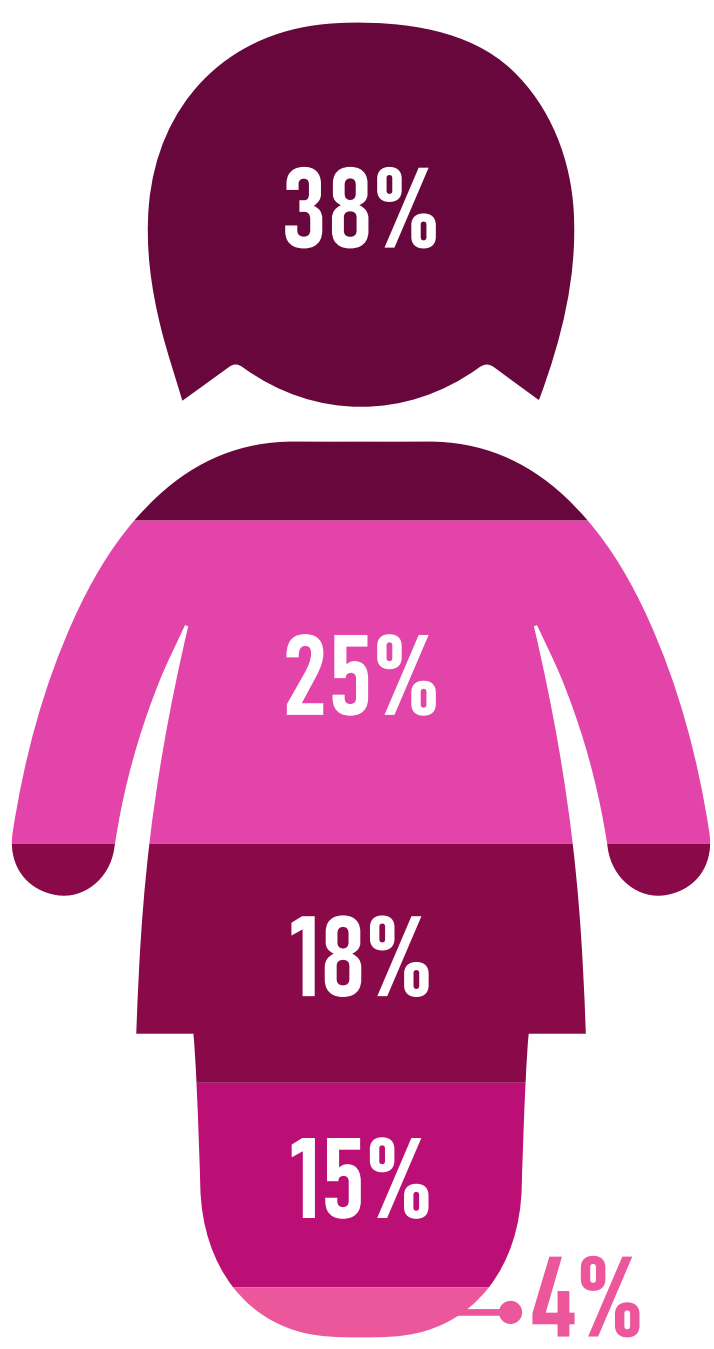


Main economic, social and cultural reasons for women's migration



VULNERABILITY

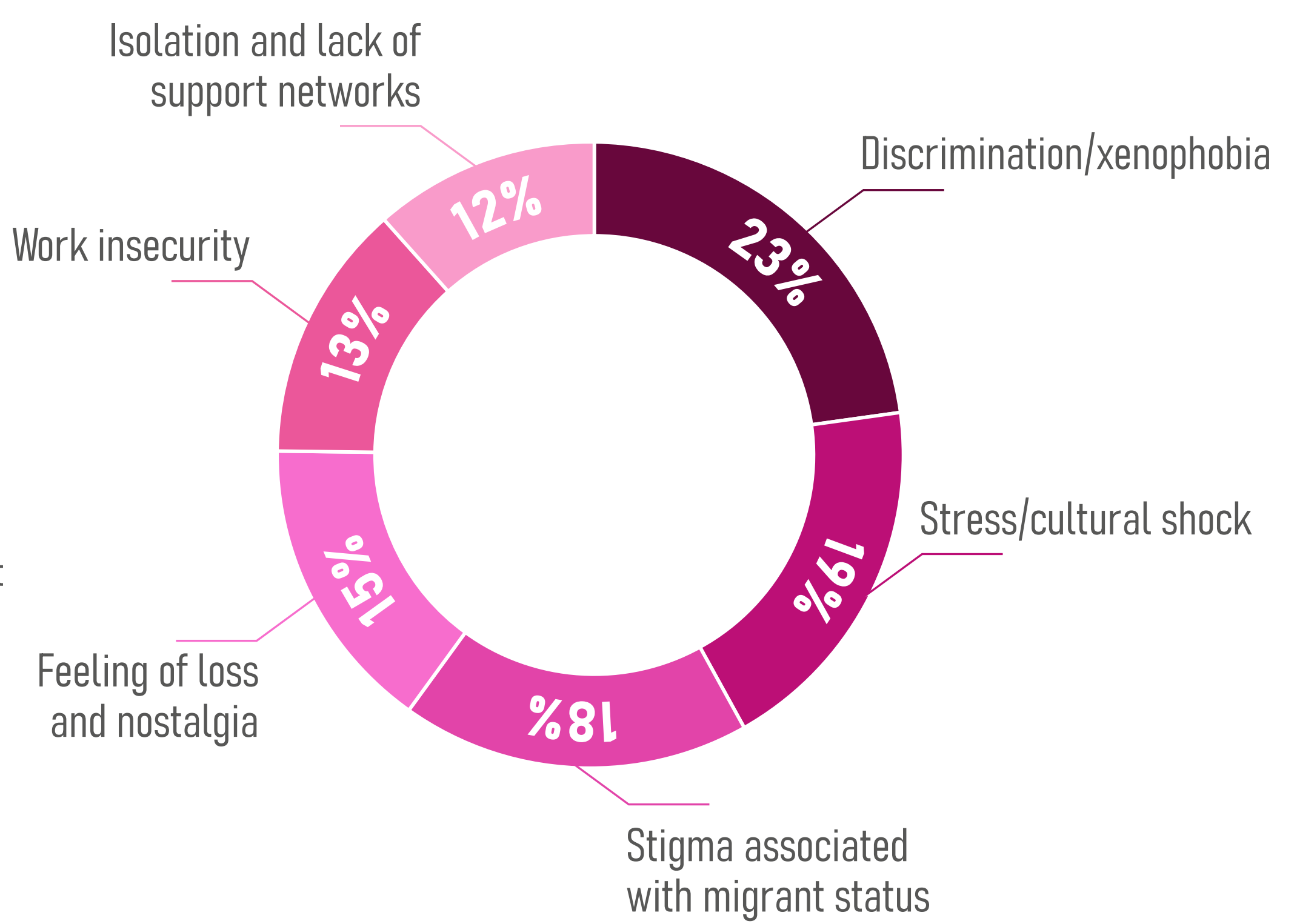
Main vulnerabilities faced by migrant women assisted by organisations

- Institutional violence

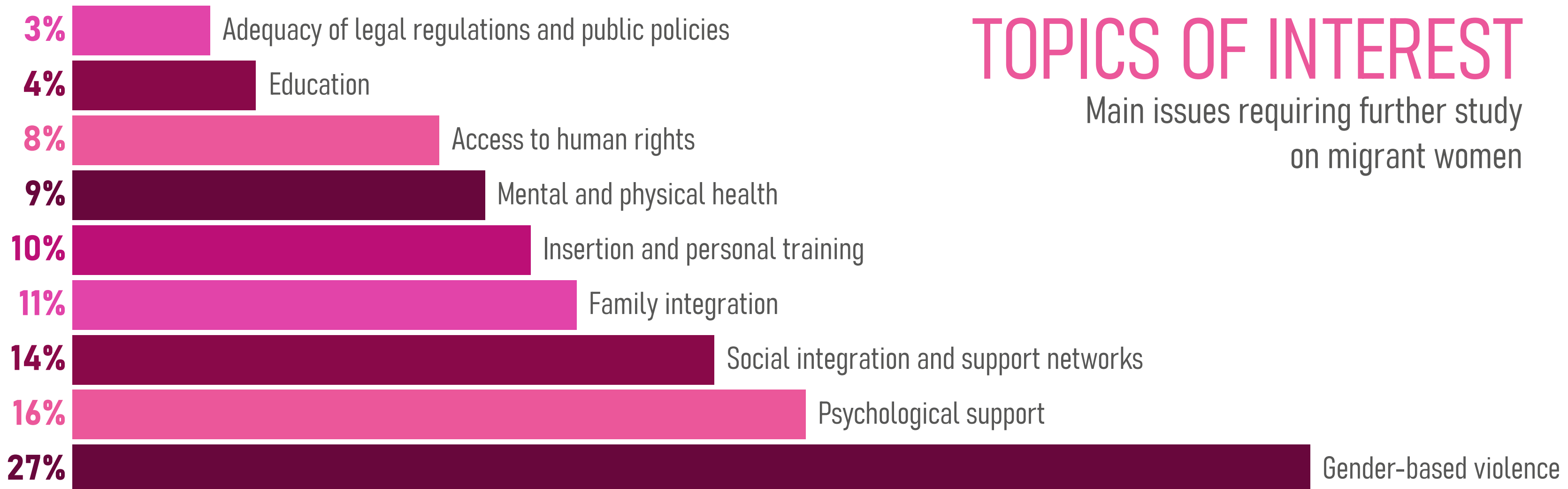
